## International Conference on new Therapies for Dementia and Parkinsonian Syndromes

The 2nd International Conference on New Therapies for Dementia and Parkinsonian Syndromes (ICDP) will take place in Florence on September 27, 2014: this is the second edition after the first successful 2013 Conference in Pisa. The conference will bring together European experts of neurodegenerative diseases coming from the academic world, hospital centres and pharmaceutical industry. The Meeting will focus on the new possibilities of preclinical and early diagnosis, and on the more innovative pharmacological and non-pharmacological therapies.

The results of clinical trials will be evaluated and discussed, as well as on-going studies and the expected outcomes, drugs' pipeline, non-pharmacological therapies, perspectives on biomarkers and on future diagnostic-therapeutic scenario and unmet needs of patients with dementia and parkinsonian syndromes. This highly condensed meeting will be repeated alternatively in Pisa and Florence with the aim of becoming a reference mark on what's new in the field of therapies of neurodegenerative diseases.
